- · Discuss any photos or x-rays you want to use to illustrate points
- Discuss what your expert can/can't testify to

7 Before Court continued

- · Share quirks of judge or lawyer
- · Share opposing strategies, if known
- Discuss cost
- · Medical experts can clarify medical issues in:
 - -Physical abuse
 - -Sexual abuse
 - -Neglect

- You are the expert
- · Help us educate the court
- · Respect goes both ways

10 AFTER COURT

11 Feedback

- What went right
 -Voice, clarity, language, displays
- What could be better

 Voice, expressions, clarity
- · Build that relationship!
