- Docket entry ok (In re T.R.); Letter is analogous
- Letter has substantive attributes of order
   Facts

  - Conclusion re: SMJ
     Indicia of veracity and officiality (stationary, facts, judge's signature)





  - Did the court have subject matter jurisdiction to hear the Rule 59-60?









































# 7B-1001: Appealable Orders Absence of jurisdiction In effect determinations action and prevents judgment which appeal might be taken Adjudication and initial disposition Change legal custody (not a NSC) PPO eliminate reunification TPR grant/deny
