### DHHS Responsibilities

- Set up credentialing body (*G.S. 7B-2401.2*)
- Review applications (G.S. 7B-2401.2)
- Notify within 45 days
- Provided certificate if approved
- Post name and contact information on DHHS website



## Forensic Evaluations

Must include a "full examination" using evidence based psychological tools (e.g., IQ tests)

Limits credentialing primarily to psychologists

Will **NOT** go through LME-MCO like adult capacity

Distinct from the LCFE credentialing process

### Standards

#### Hold a valid NC license

Experience conducting capacity to proceed evaluations

Experience using developmentally appropriate psychological tools

Knowledge in child and adolescent development and needs

Knowledge in appropriate methods for evaluating juveniles

Cover letter describing experience



Copy of North Carolina license



Resume or Curriculum Vita



Sample report

Completed in the past 3 years

Addresses a legal or forensic matter

Redacted with no personally
identifiable information



Additional data upon request

## Denials and Revocations



If denied, may resubmit after 30 days and must demonstrate how now meet the standards.



If license has been suspended, revoked, or relinquished then credential is revoked.
