## 1. Remediation Request for Proposals (RFP) Timeline

- RFP Advertisement: November 8 – December 9, 2024
- Provider Award Notification: January 17, 2025
- Provider Training: February 17/18, 2025
- UNC-Chapel Hill Curriculum Launch: March 2025
- Service Provision: April 2025





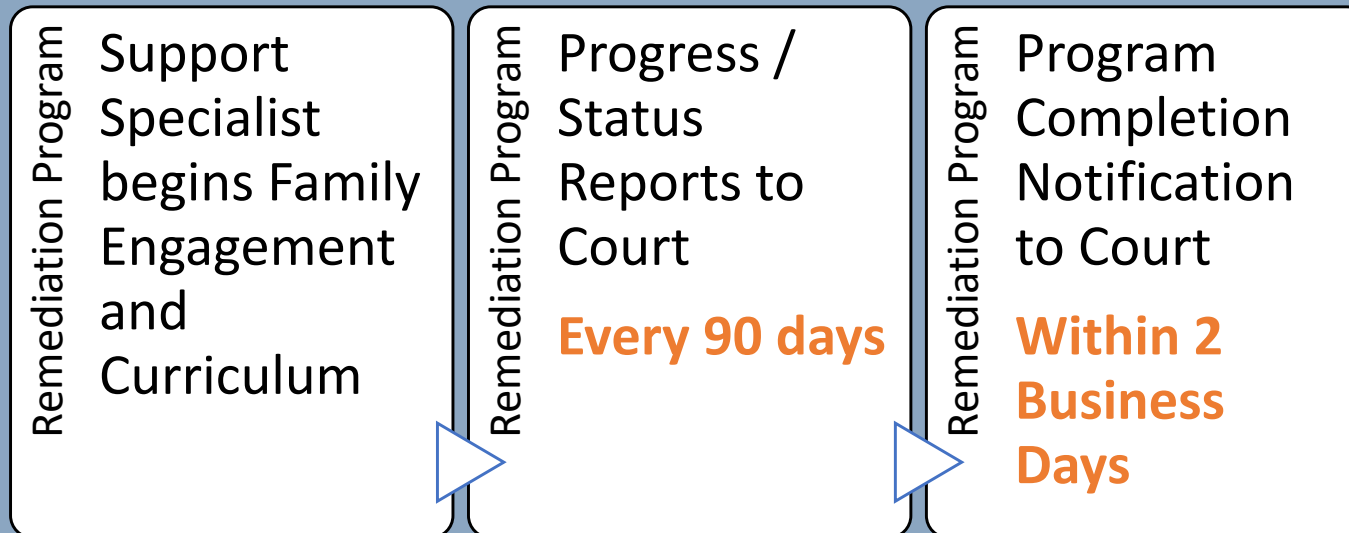
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## 2. Program Delivery and Legislative Time Frame Management





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### **Program Model**

Dyadic – 1 Support Specialist with 1 Juvenile

In-person: Detention, Hospital, School, Home, Other

Web-based curriculum

Videos, carousels, interactive “games”, in-module knowledge checks, module tests



### **Curriculum dosage:**

- 1-2 sessions per week
- Maximum of 1-hour per session
- Failure 2 x's in a module, provider moves onto next module





## 2. Program Delivery and Legislative Time Frame Management

Remediation Program Court Ordered  Program Completion

- **36-Month Maximum:** First degree murder, first-degree forcible rape, first-degree statutory rape, first-degree statutory sexual offense
- **24-Month Maximum:** 12-Month + Good Cause 12-Month Extension for other Class B1, B2, C, D or E.
- **12-Month Maximum:** 6-Month + Good Cause 6-Month Extension for Class F, G, H, I or Misdemeanor.





### 3. Juvenile Remediation Case Management Roles and Responsibilities

Program Aspect	Juvenile Court Counselor	Contract Administrator	Program Provider
Family Engagement	✓		✓
Remediation Referrals	✓	✓	✓
Additional Referrals	✓	✓*	
Court Reports		✓	✓
Statutory Mandates		✓	✓

\*Primary responsible party for additional referrals is the Juvenile Court Counselor. Contract Administrator will do a check on referrals issued.







## 4. Community Programs Contract Administrator Management

### I. Programmatic

- Progress reports – at least every 90 days
- Time frames based on offense class
- Program Completion Notification to Court
- Client tracking through Canvas: Curriculum delivery data, ex – module, % correct
- Client tracking through NC-ALLIES, statewide web-based application: Client level, demographics, successful/unsuccessful





## 4. Community Programs Contract Administrator Management

### II. Budget and Financial

- Department of Public Safety, Division of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention funds to start
- Program Budget will be negotiated at award
- Continued efforts to acquire legislative funds
