235.40 USE OF AN UNMANNED AIRCRAFT SYSTEM NEAR A FOREST FIRE. MISDEMEANOR.

The defendant, has been charged with use of an unmanned aircraft system near a forest fire.<sup>1</sup>

For you to find the defendant guilty of this offense, the State must prove three things beyond a reasonable doubt:

First, that the defendant was a [person] [entity] [State agency].

Second, that the defendant used an unmanned aircraft system.

And Third, that the defendant did so within a [horizontal]<sup>2</sup> [vertical] distance of 3,000 feet from any forest fire within the jurisdiction of the North Carolina Forest Service.

If you find from the evidence beyond a reasonable doubt that on or about the alleged date, the defendant was a [person] [entity] [State agency] and that the defendant used an unmanned aircraft system within a [horizontal] [vertical] distance of 3,000 feet from any forest fire within the jurisdiction of the North Carolina Forest Service, it would be your duty to return a verdict of guilty. If you do not so find or have a reasonable doubt as to one or more of these things, it would be your duty to return a verdict of not guilty.

<sup>1.</sup> N.C. Gen. Stat. § 15A-300.4(b) provides that "[u]nless the use of the unmanned aircraft system is otherwise prohibited under state or federal law," this section does not apply to "[a] person operating an unmanned aircraft system with the consent of the official in responsible charge of management of the forest fire," "[a] law enforcement officer using an unmanned aircraft system in accordance with G.S. 15A-300.1(c)," and "[a] North Carolina Forest Service employee or a person acting under the direction of a North Carolina Forest Service employee." See State v. Carey, 273 N.C. App. 593, 849 S.E.2d 111 (2020) (holding that the language "does not apply' is exculpatory, and is not an underlying element of the offense.").
