The defendant has been charged with feloniously [possessing] [manufacturing] [distributing] [exporting] [importing] equipment used to manufacture a [controlled substance] [listed chemical].

For you to find the defendant guilty of this offense, the state must prove two things beyond a reasonable doubt:

<u>First</u>, that the defendant [possessed] [manufactured] [distributed] [exported] [imported] any [three-neck round-bottom flask] [tableting machine] [encapsulating machine] [gelatin capsule] [equipment] [chemical] [product] [material] which may be used to manufacture a [controlled substance] [listed chemical].

And Second, that the defendant [knew] [intended]¹ [had reasonable cause to believe] that it would be used to manufacture a controlled substance.²

If you find from the evidence beyond a reasonable doubt that on or about the alleged date the defendant [possessed] [manufactured] [distributed] [exported] [imported] any [three-neck round-bottom flask] [tableting machine] [encapsulating machine] [gelatin capsule] [equipment] [chemical] [product] [material] which may be used to manufacture a [controlled substance] [listed chemical], and that the defendant [knew] [intended] [had reasonable cause to believe] that it would be used to manufacture a controlled substance, it would be your duty to return a verdict of guilty. If you do not so find, or if you have a reasonable doubt as to one or both of these things, it would be your duty to return a verdict of not guilty.
