202.60 SPEED LIMITATIONS ON BRIDGES, CAUSEWAYS, AND VIADUCTS.

The motor vehicle law provides that a special speed limitation applies to a public [bridge] [causeway] [viaduct] when it is sign-posted by the Department of Transportation as to the posted maximum speed. In such case, it is the duty of a motorist not to drive upon such [bridge] [causeway] [viaduct] at a speed greater than the posted maximum speed. In this case the posted maximum speed was (*state posted speed*).¹

A violation of this law is negligence within itself.

1. The findings and determination of the Department of Transportation shall be conclusive evidence of the maximum speed which can with safety to any such structure be maintained.
