All motorcycles<sup>2</sup> are entitled to full use of a single lane. The motor vehicle law provides that no motor vehicle<sup>3</sup> shall be driven in such a manner as to deprive any motorcycle of the full use of a single lane.<sup>4</sup>

A violation of this law is negligence within itself.
