210.35 EMERGENCY VEHICLES - INTERFERENCE WITH FIRE EQUIPMENT.

The motor vehicle law provides that it is unlawful to:

[drive a motor vehicle over a fire hose or any other equipment that is being used at a fire]

[block a fire fighting apparatus or other equipment from its source of supply, regardless of its distance from the fire].

A violation of this law is negligence within itself.
