211.55 HITCHHIKER - PEDESTRIANS SOLICITING RIDES.

The motor vehicle law provides that no person shall stand in any portion of a State highway, except upon the shoulders, for the purpose of soliciting a ride from the operator of any motor vehicle.

A violation of this law is negligence within itself.¹

^{1.} The statute contains no negation of negligence *per se*. *See*, however, the instructions (N.C.P.I.-Civil 211.40 and 211.45) regarding pedestrians crossing or walking on highways.
