215.60 SECURING LOADS - OPEN FLAT TRUCKS. N.C. Gen. Stat. § 20-120.¹

The motor vehicle law provides that it is unlawful to operate on any highway any open, flat truck loaded with [logs] [cotton bales] [boxes] [(*describe other load*)] without having the load securely fastened on the truck.

A violation of this law is negligence within itself.

1. Trucks hauling tobacco are governed by other provisions of N.C. Gen. Stat. § 20-120, not included in the above instruction.

As to dropping, sifting and leaking loads on any vehicle, see N.C. Gen. Stat. § 20-116(g).
