## 221.15 CONTROLLED-ACCESS HIGHWAY - TURNS.

The motor vehicle law provides that it is unlawful for the operator of a vehicle to make a [left turn] [semicircular or U-turn] on any controlled-access highway<sup>1</sup> except through an opening provided for that purpose in the dividing [curb] [separation section] [line].

A violation of this law is negligence within itself.

1. The statute applies to both interstate and other controlled-access highways.
