221.25 CONTROLLED-ACCESS HIGHWAY - ENTERING AND EXITING.

The motor vehicle law provides that it is unlawful for the operator of a vehicle to drive [onto] [from] any controlled-access highway¹ except at [entrances] [exits] provided for that purpose.

A violation of this law is negligence within itself.

1. The statute applies to both interstate and other controlled-access highways.
