221.35 CONTROLLED-ACCESS HIGHWAY - FAILURE TO YIELD RIGHT-OF-WAY.

The motor vehicle law provides that the operator of a vehicle entering any controlled-access¹ highway shall yield the right-of-way to any vehicle already travelling on the highway.

A violation of this law is negligence within itself.
