101.65 PEREMPTORY INSTRUCTION.

This issue reads:

"(Read issue; e.g., 'Did the plaintiff buy a 1981 Oldsmobile from the defendant on April 1, 1981?')"

The burden of proof on this issue is on (identify party having the burden of proof). This means that (identify party) must prove by the greater weight of the evidence that (state affirmative of issue; e.g., "the plaintiff bought a 1981 Oldsmobile from the defendant on April 1, 1981"). All of the evidence tends to show that (state affirmative of issue).

Therefore, as to this issue, I charge you that if you find the facts to be as all the evidence tends to show, you will answer this issue, "yes," in favor of (*identify party having the burden of proof*).

However, if you fail to find by the greater weight of the evidence that (*state affirmative of issue*), even though there is no evidence to the contrary, then it would be your duty to answer this issue, "no," in favor of (*identify other party*).
