205.10 MEETING OF VEHICLES. N.C. Gen. Stat. § 20-148.¹

The motor vehicle law provides that the operators of vehicles proceeding in opposite directions shall pass each other to the right, each giving to the other at least one-half of the main-traveled portion of the roadway as nearly as possible.²

A violation of this law is negligence within itself.

1. N.C. Gen. Stat. § 20-148 is irrelevant when the collision occurred on a three-lane highway. *State v. Duncan*, 264 N.C. 123, 141 S.E.2d 23 (1965).
